Beloved Gurudev,

On behalf of all Your Hungarian disciples and of the Hungarian Yoga in Daily Life Ashrams – their board, yoga instructors, and all members – it's an honour to congratulate you Swamiji for this special award of "Pride of India", given to you at the British Parliament.

The occasion of receiving such an award is a great opportunity to review your activities in our country. In this letter, we can evoke even the most important events only partly, your 40 year's work in Hungary being so eventful.

We remember the unforgettable pleasure of your arrival to Hungary on 7th of May 1978 and the showering of Mahaprabhu Ji's wisdom to the listeners of your satsangs during the 30 days of your first visit. You visited most of the major cities of Hungary, such as Budapest, Szeged, Miskolc, etc. With an exceptional energy you taught authentic yoga and Indian spiritual heritage to several thousands of Hungarians – just in one month.

In each month, or even multiple times in a month, you visited Hungary between 1978-1980. In weekend seminars and in summer camps several weeks long, you taught yoga instructors and everyone inclined to spirituality and yoga. There were memorable yoga camps in Virágos-nyereg (1978) and Páty (1979). We were again together in Páty in 1980 with you and your Master, Holy Guruji – His Holiness Paramhans Swami Madhavanandji. During this time we received a marvellous blessing, when you and Guruji inaugurated the Budapest Ashram which was being built at that time. This place is known as the 'Hungarian Guru Ashram' since then.

Besides the major cities of Budapest, Debrecen, Miskolc, Szeged, etc. you travelled through the whole country, Pest, Hajdú-Bihar, Csongrád, Veszprém, Somogy, Vas, and Zala counties, among others.

The village of Vép (Vas county) is one of the main venues of international Yoga in Daily Life retreats since 1993. An agricultural school was established here in 1962, within the 700 years old, 135 acre park of the former Erdődy Castle. With its old trees, its large hall and kitchen, and the 2-4 bed hostel rooms this college is an ideal place for YIDL retreats. The International Sri Deep Madhavananda Ashram Fellowship has organised here weekend and summer yoga seminars for the past 20 years. Several hundreds of Hungarian and international disciples and practitioners, from neighbouring countries and from all over the world gather hear time to time to practise yoga and the understanding between nations and religions – this being a major part of Swamiji's teachings as part of social health.
